### M2K launches jetpacks in SAARC region

India's prominent real estate entity M2K in collaboration with New Zealand's aviation company Martin Aircraft Limited launched its commercial jetpack on June 16 at the prestigious Paris Air Show.

A renowned name in real estate business, M2K marked its presence into the aviation business by introducing jetpack in India and the SAARC region. "We are the local distributor and partner of Martin Aircraft in India for which the MoU has already been signed," M2K's aviation division President Deepak Singhal told Bureaucracy Today.

The jetpack is assumed to be useful for several applications including air mobile surveillance, UAV forward supply, for fire brigade department or during the time of natural disaster as the jetpack can reach a height of 500-1000 meters in the air. "These jetpacks would be very helpful from defence perspective, especially, for police in their rescue mission," he added.

Depending on the specification the product will be priced anywhere between hundred and twenty thousand dollars to two hundred thousand dollars. While China will be signing a deal to manufacture jetpack, India's M2K is the first one to partner with Martin Aircraft Limited.
